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Department Policies and Procedures

Program and Facility Registration: Program registrations take place on our website, lewistonrecreation.gov. If you are new to Lewiston Recreation, please create an account. From here, all program and facility reservations can be completed, including payment. Please make sure your contact information, including email and phone number, are accurate. Call our main office at 207-513-3005 for assistance.

Program Payments: Program fees are due upon registration. Payments can be make on the website, through the mail, over the phone, or in person. All credit card payments are subject to a 2.5% fee.

Non-Resident Fee: Program participants who do not live in Lewiston will be subject to a Non-Resident Fee. This will range from \$1-\$50 depending on the program.

Program Cancellation: If Lewiston Recreation cancels a program due to low enrollment, registrants will receive a 100% refund.

Refunds: If the registrant withdraws from a program, a \$10.00 administrative fee will be charged, and the registrant will receive the remainder for their refund. Refunds will be made in check form, and will take 2-3 weeks to process. The registrant may choose to keep their cancellation as an account credit that can be used towards future programs.

Weather Cancellations: If the weather impacts travel to/from a program, or holding a program will be unsafe for the participants or damage a field, the decision will be made to cancel. Cancellations will be made 2-3 hours before the start of the program. Lewiston Recreation will post the cancellation on our Facebook page, and will also email registered participants. We will do our best to reschedule cancelled programs.


TEEN CAMP for Grades 6-81


Rec Readers Book Club

Mentors will support and guide mentees in personal goals, and also participate in special group events and programs! All mentors are trained, fingerprinted, and background checked before matching begins, and should plan on completing one year as an AIM Mentor.


